  - a) The 2017 Pool Open Water Swim Clinic with Olympian Alex Meyer was held on Sunday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Berkeley Aquatic Club from 11:00am – 2:00pm
    - **30** NJ LMSC members registered; **29** attended (the clinic cap was 30)
    - Special thanks to board volunteers Sarah Clark, Kim Plewa, Jen Bauman, and member/facility volunteer Sandy Bluhm for all of their help with the pool course set-up for the clinic
  - ii. The NJ LMSC had one grant reimbursement (\$180) for the coaching certification Level I and II course held in the NJ LMSC on March 25, 2017 and one grant reimbursement (\$40) for the Coaches Stroke Development Clinic held in the NJ LMSC on March 25-26, 2017
  - iii. Susan suggested the idea of an LMSC hosted Pool Open Water Event/Race/Training race as a new type of program that we could offer our NJ LMSC membership
    - a) **Kim will look into information about POWS (Pool Open Water Swim) races/events and report back to the board at the next meeting**

K. Fitness (L. Brown-Kuhn)

- i. 2017 Fitness Swim Programs
  - a) **Swim University** will be done at the end of June
    - We have 34 people registered to date and will probably get a few more
    - 2016 ended up with 48 participants
    - Linda is thinking about a non-competitive for 2018 to pump up the numbers and is open to any and all ideas
    - There are 60 drawstring bags left over from the 100 ordered in 2016, but Linda would like to order swim caps with the Swim U logo and let graduates pick which one they would like
    - Prices, including shipping, set up, and screens from Simply Swim Caps are
      - 50 black latex caps with the logo on both sides in white: \$3.43 per cap = **\$171.50**
      - 50 black super soft silicone caps with the logo on both sides in white: \$3.60 per cap = **\$180.00**
    - After this purchase, Swim University would be set for several years at least
    - The only additional cost would be postage for mailing out the swag
    - **Board consensus for Linda to purchase 50 of the black super soft silicone caps with logo on both sides for \$180**
    - **Linda will email all 2016 Swim University participants who are not participating in 2017 and encourage them to sign up for 2017**
  - b) **Last Chance Swim** is slated for late August or early September.
    - Labour Day is on September 4<sup>th</sup> this year
    - Bill is looking into possible dates (August 20, August 27, September 3, or September 10) for the Cranford Pool that we have used in the past
  - c) **Fitness Standout** ~~~ Linda will be submitting a Fitness Standout article for the May/June Fastlane issue

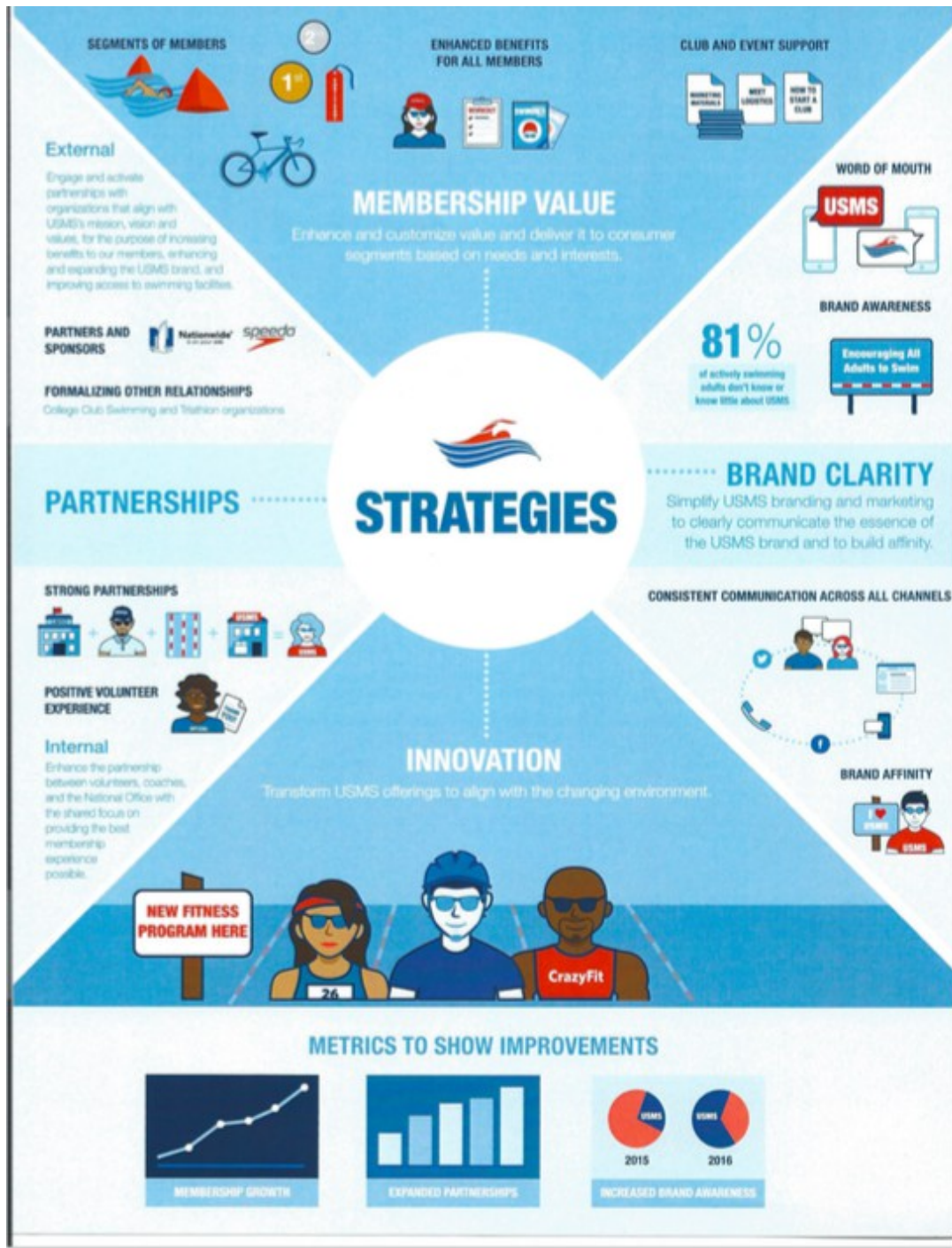

    - b) Finally there is recognition that the demographic of USMS is changing and moving away from competitive swimmers and moving towards fitness swimmers so development of programs needs to reflect these changes, especially at the National level
