## TEAMS

Four college teams will each enter a "championship squad" consisting of 11 swimmers and two divers. Squads will compete in 12 swimming events and two diving events in an "A-Finals Only" format. Each swimmer may swim two individual events and one relay per night, and there will be a swimmer representing each university in all of the final heats.

## PROCEEDS OF THE SWCCC

All proceeds will benefit the "Frank Elm Endowed Scholarship" at Rutgers University. Elm was a USA Olympic Team coach in 1968 and 1976. His Central Jersey Aquatic Club team was the pride of New Jersey for many years, as one of the best programs in America. Elm was the Head Swimming & Diving Coach at Rutgers from 1961-1993, where he was a driving force in the construction of the Rutgers Aquatic Center that has helped New Jersey swimming so much since its debut in 1991. This endowment in his name will help secure the Rutgers University swimming program for generations to come.

**RELAY SELECTION**

To be considered, times must be submitted **by Dec. 17, 2008**. Eligible teams must be within the state of New Jersey (including teams in the Middle Atlantic LSC) between Sept. 1 and Dec. 14, 2008. First choice times will be from USA Swimming meets (either the aggregate of four individual swims or a total relay performance), from invitationals (Y or otherwise), or from dual meets approved by USA Swimming. In the event a total relay time has a member that “ages up” before January 16, the time will still be considered “owned by the club.” Other dual meet/non-approved meets will only be considered after those from “approved” or sanctioned USS competitions. Proof of times will be meet results with the date the meet was conducted. For aggregate relay entries, names and ages of swimmers must also be included.
